Comments must be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to individual staff members or District employees. As required by law, Members of the Governing Board can only take action on items listed on the agenda and may not comment on the Public's Comments. Board Members may seek clarification or refer specific concerns to District Staff for appropriate attention.

No person is granted any privilege by the Board to make statements which may be considered defamatory or otherwise actionable by other persons, including District officers and employees

Discussion of personnel matters is inappropriate for open session. Complaints against employees will normally be heard in closed session, and the District's complaint procedure should be followed before discussion with the Board. All charges or complaints against employees shall be submitted to the governing Board under the provisions of governing Board policy. (cf. 1312 – Complaints Concerning School Personnel). Speakers are cautioned that under California law, no person is immune from liability for making intentionally false or defamatory comments regarding any person simply because those comments are made at a public meeting.

Please note that State Law prohibits the Board from taking any action on items not listed on the agenda.
