Dr. Suzuki gave an update on high school and middle school students returning to school on a block/hybrid schedule starting on Monday, March 22, 2021. Dr. Suzuki commended Mrs. Shelley Basham and Mrs. Tina Fulmer, as well as all the teachers and classified staff for the hard work in preparing the campuses and ensuring safety for our students. Dr. Suzuki provided information on the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and California Department of Public Health (CDPH) recommendation for social distancing. Discussion followed about the limiting factor in bringing students back full time is the distance required between students. Dr. Suzuki shared that kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade are back in class four days per week, on a shortened day, due to smaller class sizes. Dr. Suzuki shared that as we budget for next year, with Cares Act Funding, we may be able to hire additional teachers in order to maintain slightly smaller

class sizes. Options for families who wish to remain on Distance Learning or Virtual Academy were also discussed.
